As we continue to monitor the affect of the coronavirus (COVID-19) on our communities near and far, we wanted to share the actions that Redwoods Golf Course is taking to keep our facility clean and safe for our guests and employees.

We have implemented numerous changes to operations in order to be fully compliant with the Provincial Health Officer's Orders. **But we can't do this alone.** Everyone is responsible for preventing the spread of COVID-19. Below are the measures that we are diligently taking to keep our facilities safe, as well as our expectations for guests using the facilities.

Some of the steps that we are taking to reduce the potential spread of the virus are as follows:

- **Only accepting online bookings and encouraging one payment per tee time** to limit contact with public
- **All employees are wearing masks** while working indoors in public spaces
- **All employees will be at least partially vaccinated** by September 20th if they are working closely with other staff or customers. All employees will be fully vaccinated by November 1st
- **Offering indoor and outdoor dining with** distancing between tables
- **Increasing sanitation** in public spaces and commonly touched areas
- **Offering hand sanitizer** in various places around the facility

Our expectations of our guests are as follows:

- **Stay at home** if you or anyone in your household have any symptoms of COVID-19
- **Wash your hands** or sanitize often while at our facility
- **Wear a mask** while indoors at our facility

In accordance with the PHO's Orders, **as of September 13, 2021 all patrons 12 years or older must provide proof of vaccination** when dining indoors or outdoors at the Redwoods Grill, or when attending an event held at the facilities. There are no exemptions for providing proof of vaccination in these scenarios. Proof of vaccination status is not required for regular tee time golf, driving range use, or take out services.

Anyone not complying with the above expectations—employees or guests—is not allowed on the Redwoods property and will be asked to leave immediately.

We are prepared to navigate the challenging circumstances that we are currently facing with everyone's safety in mind. We will continue to monitor the risks associated with COVID-19 and other communicable diseases and we will adjust our precautionary procedures as necessary.
